



Immersive Interactive Imaging *Move Your Images from Visual Tours to RealBiz360*

Log into your “**RealBiz360**” Account

Select - “**Create Tour**”

Step 1 – Add/Edit the **Listing information**

Step 2 – Add Tour Images - Select “**Upload Images**” button

Go to File Look in - “**My Documents**” > Find “**My Visual Tours**” >**Open**>Find “**Residential Folder**”

To Add Previously Stitched Visual Tour Panoramas:

***Note:** Previously saved panoramas maybe downsized (found in your Residential Folder) this may result in low resolution output in the RealBiz360 Tour Viewer. If you want your tours to appear like what you see in our samples we recommend that you take the still images and re-stitch them with TourBuilder (see instructions found in To Stitch New Panoramas)*

- ❖ Select the images that you want to upload that were previously saved in your Visual Tours Residential File folder including your still images and panoramas
- ❖ Upload the Images and Panoramas if you choose to (please see note) – Now you should be In your “**Manage Tours**” section after uploading
- ❖ Add Scene Name/Select a Default Image/Drag and Drop the Images in the place holder that you would like them to be shown on your Tour Template
- ❖ Edit Slideshow Button to change the transitional effects and then continue to Add Audio; Customize with additional links and then Publish

To Stitch New Panoramas:

- ❖ Select the “**Stitch Images**” Button – Find the “**Residential Folder**” hold the **shift key** down on the first image and click on the last image you wish to create a panorama with. Then stitch together and save the final panorama in a new file folder or your existing Residential file folder but make sure you name it so you know that this was stitched with the Web Stitcher and not the Visual Tour Software. Close after you have finished stitching.
- ❖ Select the file folder where the newly stitched panoramas exist, select the images and select upload.

To Add Still Pictures:

- ❖ Select – Upload Images
- ❖ Find the Residential File Folder – Select the still images – Upload
